Message to the Remnant – Dec. 11, 2018 Given by Christ

(The actual message is in bold, with verse numbers for easy reference. The notes were composed by MGT.)

¹ My beloved Remnant, I am pleased with those of you who continue to study my Father's Word, the Holy Scriptures. The Father has shown His favour to those who continue to act according to His Will as expressed in the Scriptures.

Note: What are two ways that we can remain in Yahweh's favour? By continuing to study His "Word, the Holy Scriptures." Another method is to "act according to His Will as expressed in the Scriptures." In order for us to know what His Will is, we must study the Scriptures diligently.

² You, my beloved followers, are my own sheep, and I guide you through Holy Spirit, revealing to you what has been hidden and clarifying what has already been revealed. There is no other group holding to these truths that can be compared to my remnant followers. You are my children, my special people.

Note: How does our Lord guide us? Through the Holy Spirit. He tells us that it is through the Holy Spirit that there is information that has been hidden, which will be made known, and that it is through the same Spirit that will help clarify teachings for us. In addition to this, the remnant, which Christ calls His sheep, will be given knowledge about information in the Scriptures and prophecies that have already been made known. It should be comforting to the remnant that Christ calls His true followers His "special people."

³ There are, on the other hand, certain groups and individuals, who have failed to follow after the path of light, even after they have tasted the truths of my Father's Word, even after miracles and signs were demonstrated to them. Many of these have walked away, into utter darkness, but for some others, there is still hope. Pray for all of these.

Note: In contrast to the remnant, Christ's "special people," there are others who have refused to follow the Way of Messiah, even after gaining accurate knowledge of the Father's truth. Some of these people experienced miracles and witnessed very special events with their own eyes, but later decided to turn away from the Father. Our Lord tells us that such ones have walked away "into utter darkness." This verse closes, however, with a bright ray of hope for those of the remnant who have loved ones that may seem to have walked away from the Light or have taken little interest. Christ tells us clearly that for such one "there is still hope," but we must "pray for all of these."

⁴ The Father is not pleased with the churches and other religious groups or individual people who teach against His Word – both written scripture and revealed prophecy. They have set up an abomination upon the altars of their churches and have sacrificed to demons. Their offerings are not holy. Their prayers are not heard. Their abodes are filled with everything that is unclean. While praying for them, stay far away from them. Do not walk in their ways, for they are not of my

remnant followers. I have sent some of you among those groups as ambassadors of light, for the purpose of assisting some who still have ears, to walk according to the divine will of the Father. Pray for my Father's prophets and for my missionaries who are sheep among the serpent's followers.

Note: Here, in the fourth verse, the focus is shifted from individuals who have walked away from the Light, to whole groups and individuals who teach falsehood. We are told that the Father is not pleased with these because apparently they have twisted the Scriptures and the prophecies that He has revealed through His messengers. This verse has some very strong words, stating that upon their altars the false teachers have set up an abomination for sacrificing to demons. Furthermore, Christ states that neither their offerings nor their prayers are acceptable. That should be enough to make someone reflect upon their actions and as to what they are teaching others in the name of God. He says that even their "abodes" (churches or homes) are unclean. The term "unclean" is used quite often in the Scriptures to indicate both a physical and a spiritual uncleanness. Just as our Lord instructed us to pray for individuals who appear to have walked away from the Father's Light, He also tells us to pray for these false teachers. While doing so, He tells us not to become involved with them and not imitate their ways. We are told to "stay far away from them." We are reminded, as Messengers have said in the past, that the Lord does occasionally send some of His sheep into those places of worship on a mission. This mission is to help some individuals who may still be attentive to hearing the voice of truth. We are also instructed in the last words of this verse to pray for such missionaries, because they are walking among the evil one's followers. Some have been sent to various Christian denominations such as Orthodox, Catholic and Protestant; others have been sent to Buddhist, Bahai or other religious groups to help draw out people that have "ears to hear" the truth. It is our duty to pray for our brothers and sisters within the remnant, regardless of their mission.

⁵ My beloved Remnant, I give my peace to each of you who remain faithful to the Commandments.

Note: The remnant of Christ is told that provided it remains faithful to the Commandments, He will give His peace.

Prayer (Provided by St. James the Righteous)

In the Name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Lord, may I always be pleasing to you. Please send the Holy Spirit to me, as you promised to your first disciples, to grant me the wisdom and understanding to have knowledge of the Father's Holy Word.

Lord, I only desire is to walk according to the Will of the Eternal Father, and to be His humble servant.

O Heavenly Father, I uphold Your Word the Scriptures as my guide, by the direction of the Holy Spirit, as my source of knowledge about You and Your Way. Help me to retain Your words so that I may purify myself, and to teach others about Your Word.

My Lord, do not let me be numbered with those who are on Your left side, the goats and all those who wilfully turn away from You and the Light that You so graciously shed upon all humanity. May I always strive to follow Your Commandments day after day and night after night.

Christ, I humbly ask that you help me to remain as one of your faithful sheep, and give me strength when I see others walk away from you and who bring shame to your Name and the Name of the Father.

Heavenly Father, please continue to bring Light to those who walk in the darkness, so they may be converted to Your Path before it is too late. Please strengthen the missionaries that You have called to work in the fields of the world to help save more souls to Christ's sheepfold.

All honour and glory to You, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen.
